

First Net Procedure

THE SOUTH CAROLINA S S B NET.

1. The S.C. SSB Net is to be formed for three (3) primary purposes.
 - A. Fellowship.
 - B. Advancement of the Radio Art.
 - C. Traffic.
2. The net shall operate on 3915 plus or minus 1 KC. The net shall meet Monday thru Friday at 7:30 P.M. E.S.T.
3. Only Formal messages shall be counted. Informal or fone patch traffic shall not be counted. Traffic shall be handled as directed by net control and the net traffic manager shall tabulate and keep all pertinent records of traffic and advise on Proper Traffic Handling.
4. The net control each evening shall nominate a new control for the following evening. In case the nominee fails to show up, the nominator shall again act as net control. The net control shall be advised and helped by the net manager.
5. All members of this net shall follow net procedures as long as the net is in session. Normally the net should not last over 30 minutes.
6. All members calling in on the net shall be on Frequency. Non members and A.M. Stations shall be recognized at the end of regular roll call.
7. All members shall check as necessary to ascertain that they are on Frequency.
8. All members shall operate his Transmitter so as to cause a minimum of interference at all times.
9. We are to encourage and welcome all AM Stations to call in and acquaint themselves with our mode of operation.
10. The S.C. ^{NET}SSB shall follow ARRL net procedures for fone nets. "Q" signals and Symbols are not appropriate for Fone Net Operations. ei. QRU is a CW Net term and not to be used on a fone net.
11. A net manager shall be elected every year in April or May. A net traffic manager shall be elected at the same time. In case the net manager is unable to perform his duties the Traffic Manager shall have full control of the net. The election of the two officers shall take place at the S.C. Annual SSB Dinner. This Dinner will be arranged and announced by the two officers of the net. The annual meeting to be held in April or May and at a location designated by net manager and net traffic manager.
